WINTERS FROST



SIZE

Women's Medium

GAUGE

9 stitches = 1" in stockinette

NEEDLES

US Size 1 / 2.50 mm circulars
Or size needed to obtain
gauge

YARN

400 yards

Stunning String MCN fingering, Blue Mist Color

NOTIONS

Darning needle Stitch markers

CUFF

CO 64 stitches using Old Norwegian Cast On method or your using your favorite cast on.

Divide stitches evenly, 32 stitches per needle and join to work in the round, being careful not to twist the yarn and place marker if needed to indicate beginning of round.

K1, P1, repeat ribbing for 10 rounds or desired length of cuff.

Begin lace pattern for instep of sock, Needle A only.



LEFT SOCK

Needle A, knit to last 12 stitches, pm, begin with row 1 of left vine lace chart. Knit to end of round. Continue with the next 3 rows of the left vine lace chart and repeat all 4 rows until you've reached 5" or desired calf length.

RIGHT SOCK

Needle A, begin with row 1 of right vine lace chart, pm, knit to end of round. Continue with the next 3 rows of the right vine lace chart and repeat all 4 rows until you've reached 5" or desired calf length.

HEEL FLAP

Heel Flap is knit on Needle B. The instep stitches on Needle A can be left on hold. This slipstitch heel is worked flat across 32 stitches. The first 2 and last 2 stitches are always knit. Knit these 4 rows until you have 16 purl bumps along the sides of heel flap.

ROW 1 (RS): K2, SL1, K1 to last 2 stitches, K2, turn.

ROW 2 (WS): K2, purl to last 2 stitches, K2, turn.

ROW 3 (RS): K2, K1, SL1 to last to 2 stitches, K2, turn.

ROW 4 (WS): K2, purl to last 2 stitches, K2, turn.

SHORT ROW HEEL TURN

Continue knitting on Needle B for heel flap, you will now use short rows to turn the heel,

ROW 1 (RS): SL1, K18, SSK, K1. Turn.

ROW 2 (WS): SL1, P7, P2TOG, P1. Turn.

ROW 3 (RS): SL1, K to 1 stitch before the gap, SSK, K1. Turn.

ROW 4 (WS): SL1, P to 1 stitch before the gap, P2TOG, P1. Turn.

Continue working rows 3 & 4 back and forth until all stitches have been worked, there will be a K2TOG on RS and P2Tog on WS. Ending with the WS and there will be 18 stitches left.



GUSSET

Knit across 9 heel turn stitches on Needle B, place marker, this denotes the new beginning of the round. Begin round, and PU and knit into the 16 purl bumps along the edge of the heel flap. Join instep stitches and continuing with the chart pattern for instep stitches only.

PU and knit into the 16 purl bumps along other side of the heel flap, knit to marker. One round is complete now continue decreasing every other round as follows.

ROUND 1, K to last 3 stitches on Needle B, K2TOG, K1, K instep in pattern, K1, SSK, on needle B, K to end of the round. ROUND 2, K one round even, instep is in pattern.

Continue decrease rounds until you have 64 stitches. Knit foot until 1.75" less than desired foot length.

ROUNDED TOE

- *K6, K2tog* repeat to end of round. K6 rows.
- *K5, K2tog* repeat to end of round. K5 rows.
- *K4, K2tog* repeat to end of round. K4 rows.
- *K3, K2tog* repeat to end of round. K3 rows.

- *K2, K2tog* repeat to end of round. K2 rows.
- *K1, K2tog* repeat to end of round. K1 rows.
- *K2tog* repeat to end of round

There 8 stitches left, cut yarn and gather the stitches together to close the opening. Weave in all your ends, block as desired.
