YARN

One 100g skein/ 365 metres (399 yards) of a fingering weight yarn.
The pattern sample is knitted using my own hand dyed yarn.



GAUGE

36 stitches : 44 rows = 4 inches/10 cm.

Washed and blocked measurement, in stocking stitch.

NOTIONS

2.25 mm (US size 1) 32 inch (80 cm) circular knitting needle for knitting the magic loop method (you can use double pointed needles if that is your preferred method). Adjust your needle size to obtain gauge if necessary.

2 cable needles.

2 stitch markers.

Tapestry needle.



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FINISHED DIMENSIONS

8 inch (20 cm) foot circumference.

ABBREVIATIONS

CO - cast on

k - knit

p - purl

N1 & N2 : needle 1 and needle 2

ktbl - knit through back loop

k2tog - knit the next 2 stitches together

p2tog-purl the next stitches together

patl-pattern

rnd : round

ssk - Slip one stitch as if to purl, slip the next stitch as if to purl, knit the two together through the back loops

sts — stitches

1/1/1 LPC -Sl 1st st to cn and hold to front, sl 2nd st to a second cn and hold to back, k 3rd st, p 2nd st from cn, k 1st st from cn.

Pss0 — pass slipped stitch over

Toe

Using Turkish cast on, CO 20 sts, 10 sts on N1 and 10 sts on N2.

Set up : knit 10 sts on N1, and 10 sts on N2

Inc md : k1, M1R, knit to 1 st before the last st on N1, M1L, k2, M1R, knit to 1 st before the last st on N2, M1L, k1. 4 sts inc'd.

Round 2 : knit

Repeat the last two rounds 9 more times (60sts).

Foot

Knit the Lace pattern on N1 and knit all the sts on N2 until foot measures $3\frac{3}{4}$ "/9,5 cm less than the desired finished sock length (so 10 % less than the foot length).

Gusset

Rnd 1 : work instep sts in patt as set, M1R, place marker (pm) for beg of heel, knit to the end of rnd, pm for the heel end, M1L (2 sts inc'd).

Rnd 2 : work instep sts in patt as set,, knit to the end of rnd.

Rnd 3 : work instep sts in patt as set, M1R, knit to the end of the rnd, M1L (2 sts inc'd).

Rnd 4 : work instep sts in patt as set, knit to the end of rnd.

Rep the last 2 rnds until you have added 18 sts (78 sts total)

Heel

Turn heel

Work short rows as foll.

Row 1 (RS) : work instep in patt as set, knit to 1 st before second heel m, wrap next st and turn (w&t).

Row 2 (WS) : purl to 1 st before m, w&t.

Working only on the heel sts, cont as foll.

Row 3 (RS) : knit to 1 st before last wrapped st, w&t.

Row 4 (WS) : purl to 1 before last wrapped st, w&t.

Repeat rows 3 and 4 until 11 sts rem unwrapped in the middle, ending with a WS row.

Remove heel markers.

Heel flap

Work the heel flap and dec gusset sts as foll.

Row 1 (RS) : knit to the first wrapped st, *knit the wrapped st tog with its wrap ; rep from* until 1 wrapped st rem, ssk (final st tog with its wrap and the first gusset st), turn work.

Row 2 (WS) : sl1 , purl to the first wrapped st *purl the wrapped st tog with its wrap ; rep from* until 1 wrapped st rem, p2tog (final st tog with its wrap and the first gusset st), turn work.

Row 3 : sl1, knit until 2 sts rem, ssk, turn work

Row 4 : sl1, purl until 2 sts rem, p2tog, turn work.

Rep rows 3&4 until only 1 gusset st rem on each side, ending with a WS row (62 sts).

Leg

Rejoin for working in rnds, working the final gusset decs in the first md as foll.

Rnd 1: sl1, knit until 2 sts rem, ssk, work instep sts in patt as set (61 sts).

Rnd 2: k2tog, work in patt as set to end of rnd (60 sts).

Work even in patt as set until leg measures 5 $1\frac{1}{2}$, 14 cm or $1\frac{1}{2}$, 3,8cm less than the desired total length, ending with a round 5 or 13.

Cuff

Set up round : *K1, (k tbl, p1) \times 6, k tbl, p2tog, (k tbl, p1) \times 6, k tbl, k1. (29 sts). Rep from *. (58 sts).

Round 1: K, (k tbl, p) \times 13, k tbl, k.

Rep the last row 18 times or the desired length.

Weave in ends.

Repeat the pattern to make a matching pair.

Enjoy your new hand knit socks !

Stitch guide

Round 1: K1, (k tbl, p1) \times 3, k2tog, k1, yo, k1, k2tog, k1, yo, k2, yo, k1, ssk, k1, yo, k1, ssk, (p1, k tbl) \times 3, k1. (30 sts)

Round 2: K1, (k tbl, p1) \times 3, k16, (p1, k tbl) \times 3, k1.

Round 3: K1, (k tbl, p1) \times 3, yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, k1, yo, k4, yo, k1, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo, (p1, k tbl) \times 3, k1.

Round 4: K1, (k tbl, p1) \times 2, ktbl, p2, k14, p2, (ktbl, p1) \times 2, ktbl, k1.

Round 5: K1, ktbl, p1, 1/1/1 LPC, p2, yo, k3tog, k1, yo, k2, p2, k2, yo, k1, sl1, k2tog, pss0, yo, p2, 1/1/1 LPC, p1, ktbl, k1.

Round 6: K1, (ktbl, p1) \times 2, ktbl, p3, k12, p3, (ktbl, p1) \times 2, ktbl, k1.

Round 7: K1, (ktbl, p1) \times 2, ktbl, p2, k2tog, k1, yo, k8, yo, k1, ssk, p2, (ktbl, p1) \times 2, ktbl, k1.

Round 8: Repeat round 4.

Round 9: Repeat round 1.

Round 10: K1, (ktbl, p1) \times 3, k6, p4, k6, (p1, ktbl) \times 3, k1.

Round 11: Repeat round 3.


Round 12: K1, (ktbl, p1) \times 2, ktbl, p2, k4, p6, k4, p2, (ktbl, p1) \times 2, ktbl, k1.

Round 13: K1, ktbl, p1, 1/1/1 LPC, p2, yo, k3tog, k1, yo, k6, yo, k1, sl1, k2tog, pss0, yo, p2, 1/1/1 LPC, p1, ktbl, k1.

Round 14: K1, (ktbl, p1) \times 2, ktbl, p3, k2, p8, k2, p3, (ktbl, p1) \times 2, ktbl, k1.

Round 15: Repeat round 7.

Round 16: K1, (ktbl, p1) \times 2, ktbl, p2, k8, p1, k5, p2, (ktbl, p1) \times 2, ktbl, k1.
